
was that I was able to join the Emvigo family.



















There is a significant reduction in the employee count in the IT Parks and the flats and houses near to the IT parks which were given for rent has been vacated.

The canteens, hotels, restaurants and other shops near to the IT parks are deeply affected by this reduction in their customer base and thereby a considerable loss of business.





During these work from home periods, if you talk to any random employee of an IT company they would say that their work has only increased being at home as they are locked most of the times at their homes and are expected to log in to their system without giving much reasons. The old style of human interaction among the team members during discussions, meetings etc has disappeared over the past 8 months and every interaction is now in a virtual manner. 
